Ako - Quality teaching and learning

As far as parent interviews are concerned we are still holding them. A few points to follow:

- Use the Contact Tracing App when you enter the school for interviews.

- If you are sick or have a condition making you vulnerable please consider postponing and rescheduling your interview.


I fear this will become all too common as we move forward. Rest assured the children's safety and well-being along with that of the staff and school is a priority on mine and the Board's agendas.






