
Student Achievement

Last Tuesday I shared with the Board of Trustees our mid year achievement data in Reading, Writing and Mathematics. I have replicated the whole school graphs below with the blue bars for (Mid) 2019 and the Green bars for (mid) 2020.

Given the 12 months that was, the disruptions we have navigated, distance learning, staffing changes, curriculum

development and of course the health crisis and shut down, our results have remained essentially stable with very little of the 'slippage in learning' that other schools have experienced. I put that down to the excellent teachers we have, your support at home and of course the students and their resilience.

In a perfect and uninterrupted 12 months we would have liked to have seen some reduction in those achieving below the expected level and increases in those at or above the level. The last 12 months have been less than perfect conditions for learning. We have already set realistic goals to bring the learning to where it should be by the end of the learning year.



Policy Review

Each term the BoT reviews a number of school policies to keep them current and relevant for our school, staff and learners.
